The Workplace Health, Safety and Welfare Regulations (WHSWR) place a duty on employers and those in control of workplaces to manage and run their workplaces in such a way as to ensure that the health, safety and welfare of people who use the premises is not adversely affected.

The Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2007 (CDM 2007) recognises that clients who create ‘workplaces’ through their construction projects and the designers of those projects, have a role to play.

So what does CDM 2007 require of designers, and by implication what do CDM-C s need to do when they “*take all reasonable steps to ensure that designers comply...*” (20(2)(c))?
